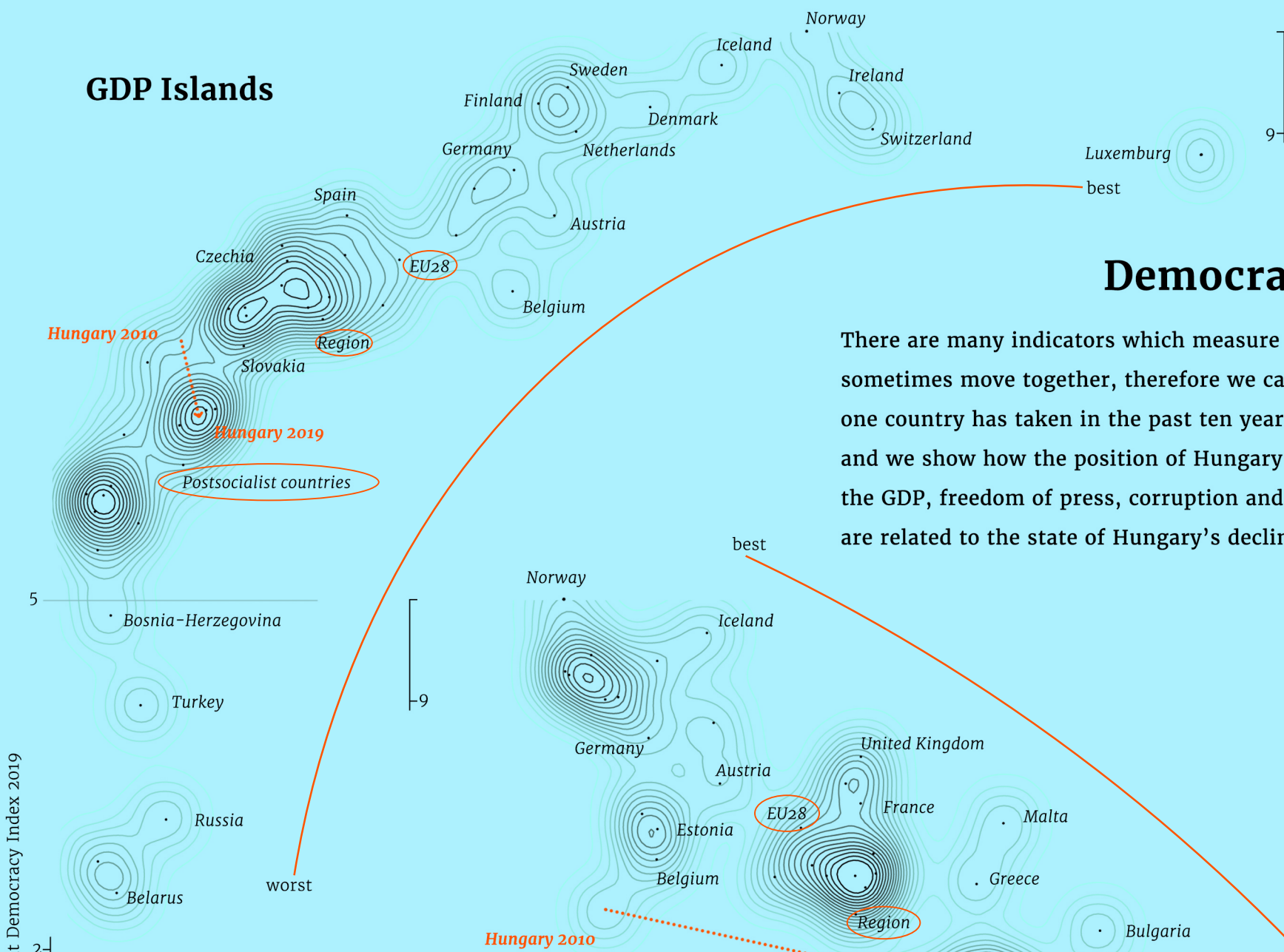
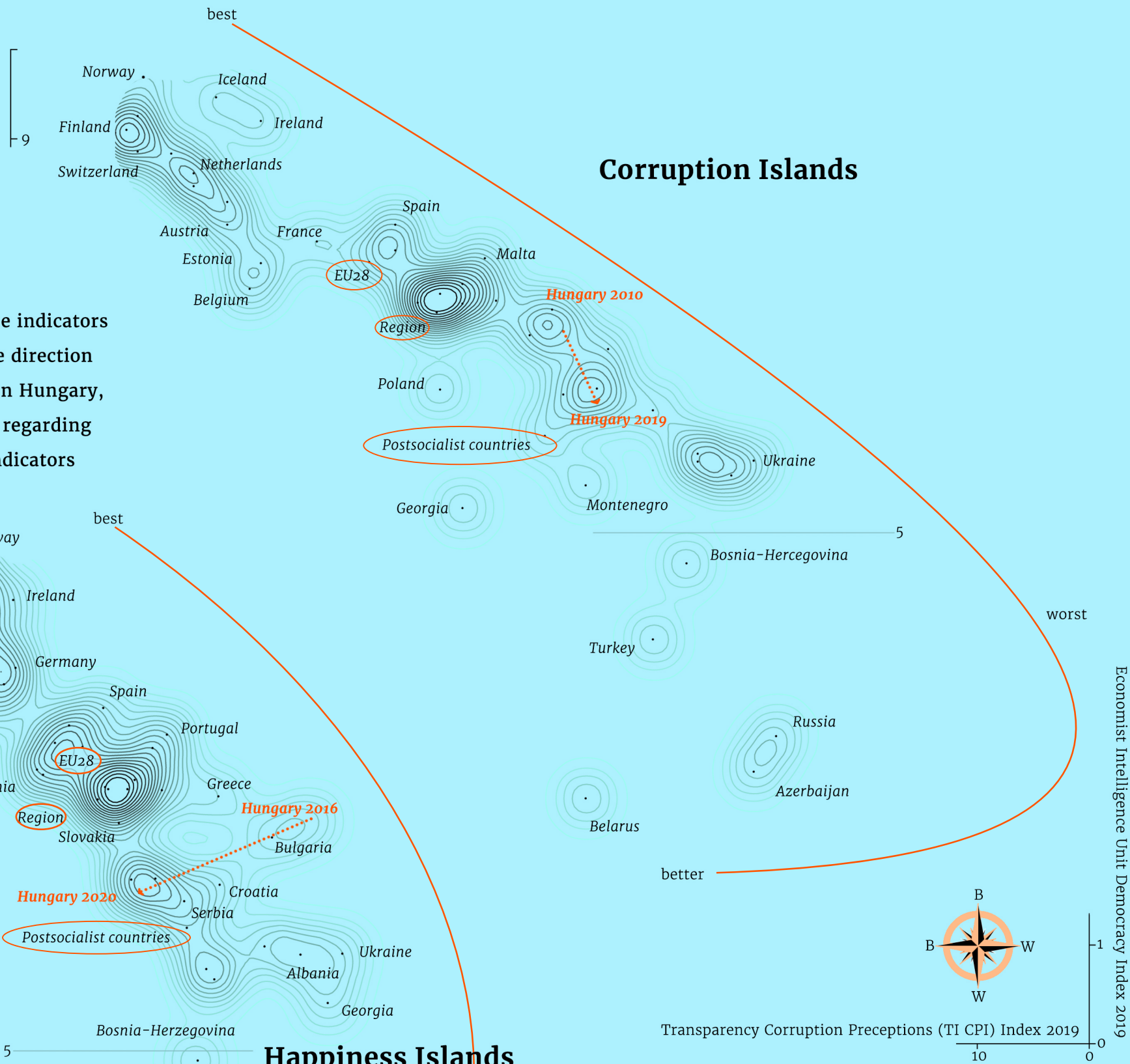

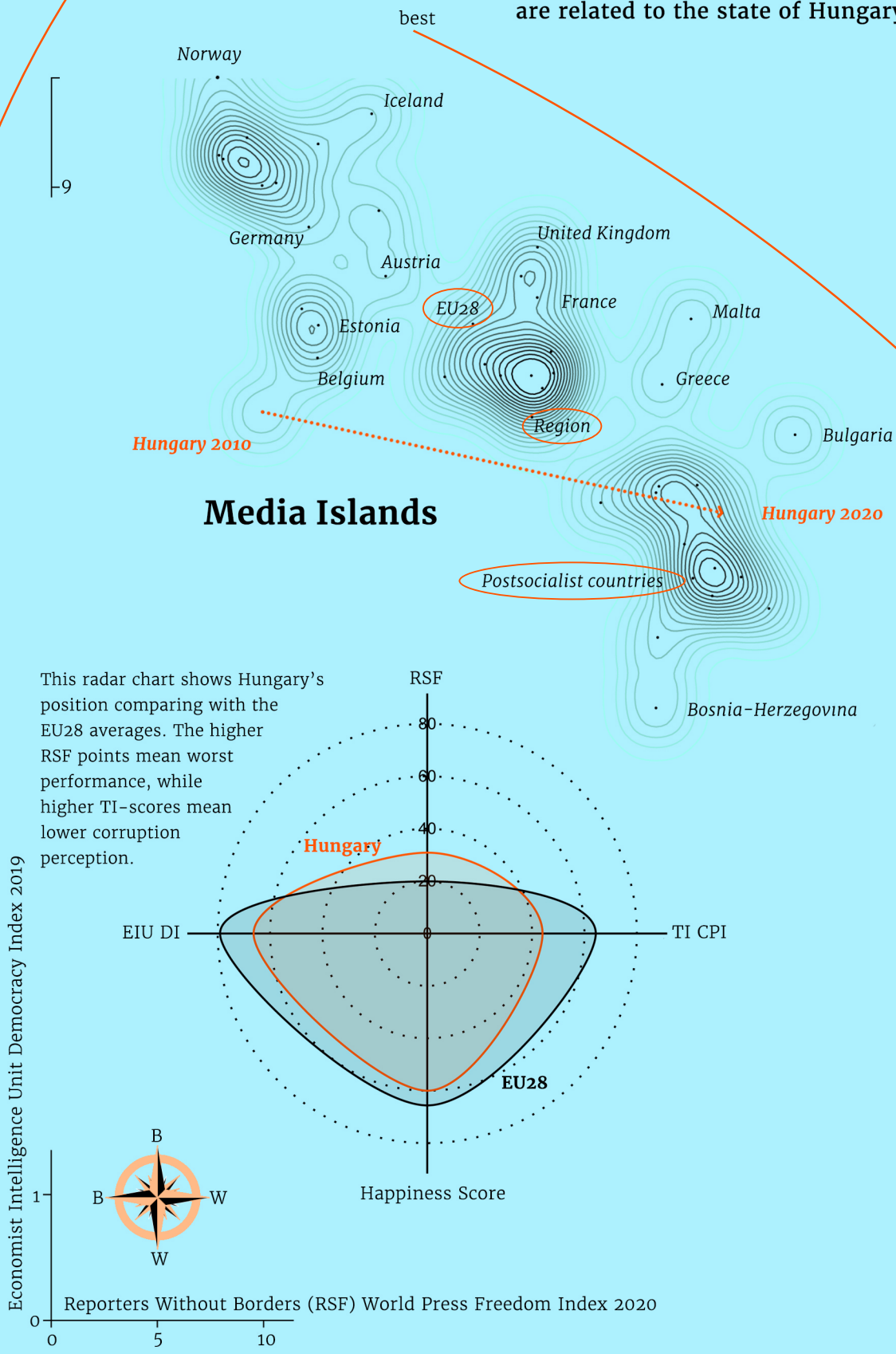

How to read?

The archipelagos should be read as a correlational point diagram. The difference is that the density and the thickness of the contour lines emphasize the density of the dots. Hungary, the EU28 average, the regional average and the average of the Postsocialist countries are highlighted with orange. We also show the direction of Hungary according to the points given the respective years. On the compass: B=better, W=worst
